# Welcome, New Community Connections Manager Patrick Kilbane!

We are happy to announce the addition of Patrick Kilbane to the Community Connections Team. Patrick has worked as an SSA at Riverside since 2016, and worked closely with the Community Connections Team to create opportunities for people on his caseload. He has been sharing the role and working alongside previous Community Connections Manager Krista Smith, whose last day working with us is October 11. In his new role, Patrick oversees the day-to-day operations of the recreation and advocacy programming offered by Riverside, in addition to serving as the Local Coordinator for Miami County Special Olympics.

Patrick brings a wealth of knowledge and experience in the developmental disabilities field to his new role. Before joining Riverside as an SSA, he worked at the Pickaway County Board of Developmental Disabilities as a Business Liaison working with adults with disabilities seeking employment, as well as serving as the local lead for the Bridges to Transition program in Madison and Pickaway Counties. In Pickaway County, he also held positions as a Transition Services Specialist and an Intervention Specialist at Brooks-Yates School. In his time at Riverside, Patrick has served as a LifeCourse Ambassador, educating professionals, families and people with developmental disabilities on the benefits of using worksheets from the LifeCourse Toolkit for life planning. He also serves as a volunteer co-chair on the Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) as well as Medicaid Block Planning group through the Ohio Department of Health.

Patrick holds bachelor's and master's degrees in special education from the University of Toledo. He lives in Arcanum with his wife, Ashley, their 3 children and beloved goldendoodle, Opal. - Contact Patrick Kilbane at 937-310-3260 and leave a message or email cc@riversidedd.org.
- Wait for a call or email confirming your activities.
- For Pre-Pay events:
  - Mail a check (made payable to Riverside Recreation) to Riverside, ATTN: Patrick. You must include the name and date of the event in the memo portion of the check. OR
  - Drop off a check or exact change payment (in an envelope) at Riverside in metal drop box by the front lobby door.
  - Call to cancel if you cannot make it to an activity you are registered to attend. We often have a waiting list for events and activities. Too many no-call/no-show activities risks your ability to register for future events.
  - We cannot provide refunds for events that are pre-pay if you do not show up to the event.

#### **Riverside Code of Conduct**

Participation in Riverside's Community Connections and Special Olympics activities are a privilege, not a right. Those who participate in any activity are expected to follow our Code of Conduct (below), aimed at ensuring a safe, healthy and enjoyable environment for all.

- I will exhibit agency core values of Respect, Integrity, Teamwork and Accountability while engaging in Riverside programs.
- I will respect the dignity of all.
- I will act in ways that bring respect to me, Riverside staff, volunteers and my peers.
- I will practice good sportsmanship.
- I will not use bad language.
- I will not swear or insult other people.
- I will not fight with anyone.
- I will not attempt to intimidate, manipulate, harass or fight with others.
- I will not make inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal or sexual advances toward others.
- I will not misuse or attempt to damage Riverside property or equipment.
- I will display appropriate behaviors at all times.
- I will not have a firearm, knife or other dangerous object on my person.
- I will report any illegal or unethical behavior observed during a program to Riverside staff.
- I will hold myself accountable for my actions.
- I will not willfully interfere with, disrupt or prevent the orderly conduct
  of any supervised program being conducted by Riverside staff or
  volunteers.
- I will obey all laws and Riverside and Special Olympics rules.

Those who fail to follow the Code of Conduct while attending a Riverside event will be subject to disciplinary action, which could include: verbal warning, written warning, immediate ejection and/or suspension based on the severity of the offense.
